## **OLD BUSINESS:**

1. Scholarships – Chris Croft stated that the five \$750 scholarships were presented to the winners at the senior awards banquet.
2. Fees for eNewsletter – Neil Crawford explained that the boosters had requested an update that would cost \$10.00/month or \$120.00/year. Neil also explained that he would like to buy a \$25 gift certificate for the person designing and distributing the eNewsletter. Ed Newhouse moved to approve both items, Craig Creamer seconded, motion passed.
3. Drive-A-Thon with Future Ford – Darrell Yasutake explained that the majority of the funds raised would go to specific teams and that he would provide a breakdown of where the funds should go.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

1. UMDAF Update (Darrel Yasutake) – Darrell discussed the goals of the UMDAF. Their main focus is large fundraising to benefit the sports programs at the six MDUSD high schools. The UMDAF is trying to raise about \$200,000 and has already raised \$100,000. It was suggested that all six high school booster groups get together to ensure that everyone is getting and receiving the same information. Steve Hayward (sp?) is trying to work with Live Nation to get a fundraiser together. Bottom line is we are having ALL FALL SPORTS. The next UMDAF meeting is Thursday, June 4, 2009 at Clayton Valley multi-use room at 7 p.m.
2. UMDAF Fundraisers (Dave Racitti) – Dave talked about the various forms of fundraising:
  - Local fundraising (Chevy's, Sports Clips, etc)
  - Business fundraising
  - Grant WritingThere will be an E-waste fundraiser on June 20. More fundraisers are in the works.
3. E-SCRIP (Craig Creamer) – Craig spoke of the importance of getting all families of athletes signed up for e-scrip beginning with Safeway. You can also sign up your credit/debit cards. This could easily make \$150,000 a year. There are other e-scrip opportunities out there that Craig & Joanne Creamer will be working on. They are looking for two volunteers to assist them with inputting information.
