ATHLETIC BOOSTERS
MEETING MINUTES

Monday, September 14, 2009

LOCATION:

CPHS Room A-2

BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT:

President Chris Croft, Vice President Ed Newhouse, Co-Treasurers Christina Humm and Bev Anderson, Boys At-Large Rep Jim Koutsoubinas, Girls At-Large Rep Neil Crawford, Spirit Wear Rep Mara Villa, Secretary Dian Bechter

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chris Croft

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Christina Humm reviewed the CPHS Athletic Boosters Balance Sheet, Cumulative Team Cash Balances, and Profit & Loss by Class. Booster's money comes in for sports teams through the Crab Feed, baskets designated to a specific sport and booster sign-ups. Some teams elect to have their funds run through the school Treasurer (Lyn Jones). Receipts need to go to Bev Anderson for reimbursements and there must be a form filled out. Anything over \$200 must be board approved. Bev proposed to pay Craig Creamer for the Challenge t-shirts. A motion was made, seconded, and approved.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. The Athletic Trainer Contract has been sent to Chad for his approval. Ed Newhouse is waiting to hear back from Chad.
2. The Raiders Fundraiser date will be Sunday, November 15 (Oakland vs Kansas City). We need to promote this event and sell tickets. The Boosters will receive \$14 for each ticket sold.
3. Sports Night date for winter sports has yet to be confirmed. Wednesday, October 28 is being looked at as a possible date. At this event, parents can meet the coaches, meet the trainer, hear about UMDAF (contributions), and learn about the Athletic Boosters.
4. The Future Ford event is Saturday, September 19 from 10 am to 3 pm at Future Ford Concord. CPHS Athletic Boosters will receive \$20 for each test drive. One adult per household. Jim Keck is spearheading a BBQ to be done by the wrestling team. Ed suggested putting this event on the marquee.

5. Falcon Feast is in the works and trying to secure additional restaurants. Currently have commitments from Kinder's, Tahoe Joe's, Mr. Lucky's. The Leadership group is committed to advertising for the Falcon Feast and will set up a schedule of dates for the restaurants.
6. Russ Carroll also reported that there are approximately 175 Booster members signed up with about \$11,000 on the books.
7. Mara Villa will have Spirit Wear available at Back to School night on Thursday, September 17. Also, Spirit Wear will offer a Letterman jacket
8. Booster seating section was brought up, but this will wait for future discussion.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Booster Discount cards will be available for \$10/adult. The District has stated that discount cards will be accepted at all DVAL games. The discount to get into an event will be:
 - a. \$8 ticket get in for \$5
 - b. \$5 ticket get in for \$3
2. Lyn Jones (school treasurer) has asked the Boosters for help at the gates to collect money. The gate money goes to the district. Darrell Y mentioned that gate receipts from all district games will be put into a special sports fund. UMDAF will oversee this special sports fund to see that this money goes back into the sports programs.
3. The Athletic Boosters received a "needs" request from several coaches requesting money toward their team. The Board needs to determine what the criteria are and if there will be a limit on requests. The Board will vote at the meeting on Monday, September 21 on approving these requests.

UMDAF:

1. Talk of a Benefit Concert at the Concord Pavilion, but on hold until spring.
2. 5K run scheduled for Sunday, October 18 at Newhall Park in Concord to raise money for UMDAF. They want to encourage students to get sponsors and try bring at least \$200 per student. The goal is to raise \$200,000 from the 5K run for UMDAF.
3. Word needs to get out about student athletic contribution to encourage all athletes to pay the recommended "donation". If the "donations" are not received, winter and spring sports may not be available.

NEXT MEETING:

The Athletic Booster meeting is scheduled for Monday, October 5 at 7 p.m. at Sports Basement in Walnut Creek. There will be a Crab Feed meeting on Monday, September 21 at 7 p.m. at CPHS, Room A-2.

MEETING ADJOURNED:
